Jellyfish

Paper size: minimum 6x6 inches Paper type: tissue paper, napkins

1. Hold the paper from the center, letting it drape down.




Crumple.



3. Turn it upside down.



4. Hold where indicated. Open up and invert the four corners at the top, bringing them down.



5. Crumple again.



Hold where indicated. Open up and invert the top part downward.



7. Open the bottom and separate the 4 tentacles. Crumple, thin and shape each tentacle.



8. The completed Jellyfish.
